### **Wealth Management Standards Board Indonesia Launched Dual Certification Program**

Jakarta, April 5, 2018 - Wealth Management Standards Board Indonesia (WMSBI) in collaboration with the Indonesian Banker Association (IBI) today officially launched *Dual Certification Program* to the public. This partnership which took place in Jakarta today was confirmed through a signing ceremony between WMSBI Supervising Board Omar S Anwar and IBI Chairman , Zulkilfi Zaini.

*Dual Certification Program* is a program which facilitates training and exam for Certified Wealth Manager (CWM) which is recognized by Lembaga Sertifikasi Profesi Perbankan (LSPP) and Certified International Wealth Manager (CIWM) recognized by The Association of International Wealth Management (AIWM), in Switzerland.

For *Dual Certification Program* in Indonesia, WMSBI appointed Magister Manajemen Universitas Gajah Mada (MMUGM), Priority Banking School (PBS) and Lembaga Pengembangan Perbankan Indonesia (LPPI) as the *official training provider*.

The Program will be conducted twice a year with a duration of 20 days. The first *Dual Certification Program* will start on April 12, 2018.

In his opening remarks, Omar S Anwar explained “To be able to compete in the global era, the financial industry sector should not only fulfill their competency to meet local standard but must also has the capability to compete internationally”. “*Dual Certification Program* can increase the capacity, competency and the existence of local *wealth manager* and *wealth manager* candidates in Indonesia to enable them to be globally competitive ,” adds Omar.

While Zulkilfi Zaini stated “To increase the financial industry human capital competency is a must.” The integration of the financial industry sector in ASEAN (AEC), will create and increase global competition and cooperation between industry. The increase competency of the human capital will help the national financial industry to maximize and benefit from ASEAN Economic Community (AEC). “
